Job Description

RMEK 2026 Municipal Biting Fly Program:

The Rural Municipality of Eastern Kings (RMEK) budgets for an annual municipal biting fly program which includes treatments for black fly and mosquito populations within the municipal boundaries.

The Field Worker position will commence on Monday, May 04, 2026 or later and continue until a date in August, to be determined by start date.

Work Plan

Field Worker Employee(s) report to the Team Lead for their daily work plan. Field Workers will complete a variety of support tasks, which may include but are not limited to: writing data into sheets, carrying dry or liquid larvicide and other equipment. Field workers need to have legible hand printing/writing and numeracy skills and be able to follow directions. Previous work out of doors would be highly beneficial for this program.

Operations & Work Plan

Physical Requirements:

This job requires employees to be physically fit to:

- Hike along pathways, streams, brooks, marshes and through woods and fields of the Eastern Kings area to provide support for the Team in the treatments for black fly and mosquito larvae.
- Employees will be required to carry up to 30 lbs of equipment and or larvicide product through the day.
- Some clearing of pathways, to and from the brooks is generally necessary throughout the season.
- Employees will be responsible for providing their own personal equipment and carrying their own backpack, along with any other supplies needed: Water, snacks, hats, boots, bug spray.

Environmental Requirements:

- The Employee/Municipality shall adhere to legislation, regulations and bylaws pertaining to the protection of the environment including but not limited to the *Provincial Water Course and Wetland Protection Regulations* and Section 35 of the *Pesticide Control Act* General Regulations.
